Week	What to do...	Words to practice...
Week 1 – 24 <sup>th</sup> Feb	Collect three small objects that tell us about YOU. Think what they say about you, what you like doing and if they were something from a life event.	Contractions – it's, it'll, I'll, she'll, wouldn't, shouldn't
Week 2 – 2 <sup>nd</sup> March	Research about who the first explorers were and where they went and what they discovered.	Using a or an in front of words starting with vowels and consonants
Week 3 – 9 <sup>th</sup> March	Choose 1 explorer from last week and write a fact-file poster about them – where they went, what they found, the routes they took and what they brought back to the UK.	Flyer/flier Flour/flower
Week 4 – 16 <sup>th</sup> March	Research animals that are under threat in the oceans and seas due to climate change. Make a poster for each animal you do.	Fort/fought Foaled/fold
